

2026 FIM National Summit Graphic Design Support

The Food is Medicine Institute (FIMI) is seeking support from a master's level student to develop graphic design assets for the 4th Annual Food is Medicine National Summit. The selected individual will be responsible for developing the assets listed [here](#), guided by the direction of the Manager for Partnerships and Events. Additional assets may be requested.

Roughly 10% of the listed assets have established templates for editing; another 60% have established design direction; all will generally adhere to [Tufts branding guidelines](#). The hired individual is welcomed and encouraged to use these guidelines and templates creatively to generate engaging visual content.

The individual will be responsible for adhering to the established timelines (see asset list) to provide adequate time for review and revisions. The individual will work closely with the manager to ensure alignment on content, tone, and visual coherence. This is an hourly paid position; rate will be commensurate with Tufts student worker guidelines and relevant experience.

Applicants should indicate their weekly availability (hours/week), and whether this is expected to vary over the coming months. Pending successful design of the listed assets, additional design opportunities (for example, in support of FIMI's nutrition policy initiative) may be available.
